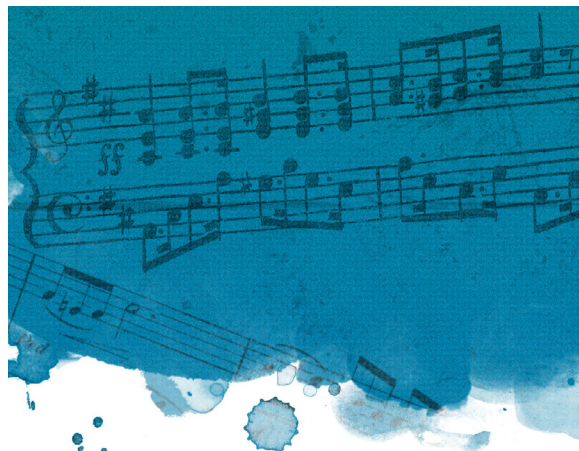

Irving Middle School

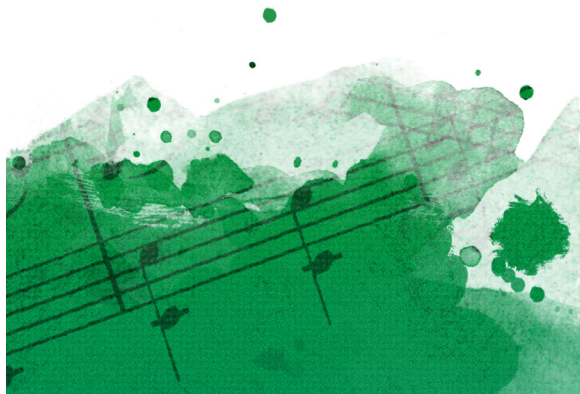

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CAMP INFORMATION

Who will be participating in the choral music camp?

The 5th grade choral music camp is open to any student who has completed the 5th grade this year (2020-2021) in the Lincoln Public School District.

When and where will the camp be held?

The camp will be held Monday, June 14 through Friday, June 18. Rehearsals will be from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at Irving Middle School in the vocal music room.

Does it cost to participate in the camp?

There is a \$25 charge to participate in the camp. Camp limited to 40 participants.

What kind of choral music groups will I be participating in?

There will be large and small ensembles. Everyone will participate in the large ensemble and small ensembles will be created once the camp has begun.

What type of music will I be performing?

Music for this camp will range from folk songs to contemporary choral music.

Will there be a final performance?

Yes! A final performance is scheduled for Friday, June 18 at 11:00 a.m. Performance is open to two family members only.

What will I be learning at camp?

This camp will focus on the basic vocal skills needed to be successful at the middle school level. Each choir member will experience how the voice works and how to use that knowledge to become a better singer. Movement will also play an important part of this camp. We will do several movement activities and add choreography to some of the songs.
